4.	<b>Treasurer's Report</b>  <b>Geoff Wilson</b>	<b>Financial Summary for 2024</b> Ali Matheson has completed audit, so figures confirmed and full report available. Summary is: Overall funds have increased over 2024 by \$17K due to difficulties getting projects completed. There were a reduced number of fund-raising events in the year, with core activities (Trivia night and uniform sales) producing good income. Funds at end of 2024 Cash \$67.7K, building fund \$30.3K, Total \$98K Funds at end of 2023 Cash \$66.8K, building fund \$14.3K, Total \$81K  <b>Income</b> Voluntary contributions down 10% countered by building fund contributions up 15% Slight increase in Trivia night income to \$8.1K
